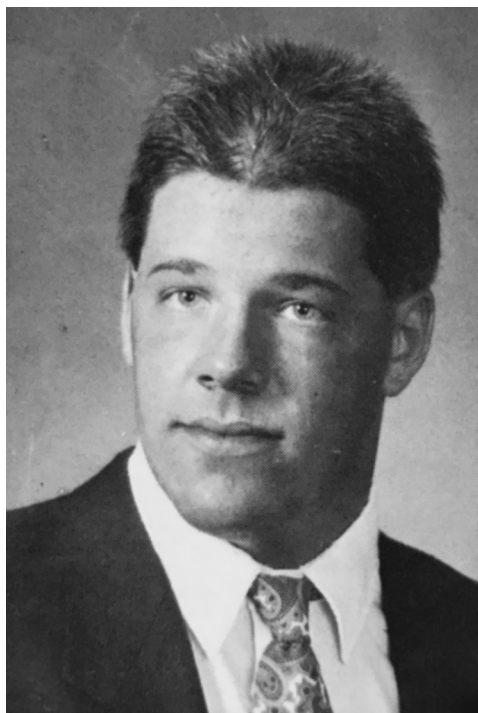

At 6 foot 5 and 255 pounds, Kevin Dakin had the gift of size, but hard work and athleticism combined to maximize his skills on the gridiron. An excellent student, he understood the game and established himself as a dominant force on the offensive line. Kevin was a 3 Year Starter at center in football, and a member of the track and field team. In football, he was an SMC league all-star, a two year Standard Times all-star, played in the Shriners All-Star Game, and received the Block of Granite award for the best lineman in the area. He started at center and defensive end. Kevin was recruited to play football at the highest level. He originally signed with Clemson, then transferred to Boston College and finished his football career at the College of the Holy Cross. He was Athlete of the Year at Bishop Stang in 1990. On the track team, he threw the shot put more than 50 feet, earning league all-star honors. Kevin's throwing helped the Stang Indoor Track and outdoor Track & Field state championships in his senior year in Division 4.
