RELEASED TIME FOR RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION

The Board of Education shall permit students with written permission from a parents/guardian to be absent from school a maximum of 60 minutes per week for religious instruction outside of school during the required school day. The scheduling of all released time shall be maintained and controlled by the local school administration in consultation with faculty, parents/guardian, and students.

The Board shall deny the privilege of release time to students who absent themselves from religious instruction after requesting the privilege.

Transportation to and from religious instruction shall be the responsibility of the parents/guardian or sponsoring religious organization, and the Board shall be released from all liability for a student absent from school for religious instruction.
