445

STUDENT INVESTIGATION, INTERROGATION, ARREST AND SEARCH

According to state law, no person knowingly may obstruct or without good reason refuse to aid law enforcement officials in the performance of an act in their official capacity.

School officials shall cooperate with appropriate law enforcement agencies regarding the investigation, interrogation, arrest and search of students on school property or in the school building according to the established procedures and consistent with District obligations concerning the confidentiality of student records under applicable state and federal law.

In spite of any of the statements contained herein, in all cases of investigation, interrogation, arrest or search of students involving law enforcement agencies or their personnel, the District assumes no responsibility for the legality of the acts or conduct of District employees or officials when such acts or conduct have occurred as a result of the law enforcement agency or its agent's directives, instruction or orders. The District shall maintain the confidentiality of student records as required by state and federal law.

The District, in conjunction with the local law enforcement agencies, shall provide the school personnel, the Board of Education, and students with annual in-service in regards to investigation, interrogation, arrest and search of students.
