SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Education recognizes that the schools in the District belong to all people, are supported by them, and are designed to carry out their wishes for the education of District students.

The Board shall be comprised of seven members elected from the District as provided by state law. Board members shall be elected from the following areas:

1. two from the Neopit-Zoar area;
2. two from the Keshena area;
3. one from the South Branch area; and
4. two at large.

Each member of the Board shall be elected for a term of three years, unless elected to fulfill an unexpired term of a regularly elected member.
