

**MENOMINEE INDIAN SCHOOL DISTRICT**

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**SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS**

Regular elections shall be held on the first Tuesday in April.

Special elections may be called by the Board of Education in accordance with procedures outlined by state law.

There shall be a written notice of all regular elections, which notice shall be given by publication no later than the fourth Tuesday in November. Arrangements for the elections, including publications, shall be the responsibility of the Board.

Except as otherwise provided, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday in January, a qualified elector may file a written declaration of candidacy with the Board Clerk. Immediately upon the expiration of time for filing declarations of candidacy, but no later than 5:00 p.m. on the second Tuesday in January, the clerk shall verify declarations of candidacy.

Balloting at school elections shall be by printed ballot. The ballots shall be printed on plain paper with the candidate's legal names appearing in the order drawn by the Clerk.

Ballots are counted and sealed by the municipal election officials and inspectors.
