

**MENOMINEE INDIAN SCHOOL DISTRICT**

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**POLICY DEVELOPMENT AND REVISION**

The primary responsibility for proposing Board policies rests with the District Administrator, however, policies may be proposed by any Board member, staff member, citizen or group of citizens in the District.

Policy proposals shall be submitted to the Board, through the District Administrator, prior to a regularly scheduled meeting. Final action to adopt new policies or amend or rescind existing policies shall be taken no earlier than the next meeting following the one at which the proposal is made.

The Board shall establish a policy committee that shall continuously review policies and make recommendations to the Board. The purpose of such review shall be to strengthen the operation of the Board and to improve the educational program of the school.

The District Administrator shall annually review the policies and make suggestions in writing for new policies and changes.
