SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

Special Board meetings shall be held upon the written request of any Board member. The Clerk, or the President in the Clerk's absence, shall provide notice specifying the time and place of the meeting to each Board member at least 24 hours before such meeting, in accordance with state law. Special meetings may be held without prior notice if all Board members are present and consent, or if every Board member consents in writing even though he/she does not attend.

Special Board meetings shall be held in the location officially designated for regular Board meetings, unless otherwise determined by the Board.

Public notice of special meetings shall be given in accordance with state law and established procedures.
