**CLOSED SESSIONS**

Board meetings shall be open to the public, except that the Board, upon a majority vote, may go into closed session for those purposes specifically authorized by state law.

Such purposes may include certain personnel considerations, deliberating the purchase of property, investing of public funds, conferences with legal counsel, competitive bargaining reasons, or other matters judged to be in the best interests of the District and in accordance with state law.

No motion to hold a closed session or to adjourn an open session into a closed session may be adopted, unless the Board President announces to those present at the meeting the general nature of the business to be considered at the closed session and the specific exemption(s) under law by which the closed session is authorized. No other business may be taken up during that session.

The Board shall give public notice of all closed sessions in accordance with state law and Board policy.
