### ADVISORY COMMITTEE PROCEDURES

#### Community Advisory Committees

The Board may form community advisory committees to study specific concerns of the District.

1. Ad hoc community advisory committees shall consist of:
  - b. At least one Board member to serve as the committee chairperson.
  - c. A maximum of five community participants, who shall be residents who live within the exterior boundaries of the District. When possible, all four community areas (Zoar, Neopit, South Branch, Keshena) shall be represented.
  - d. One administrator.
  - e. One certified staff member.
  - f. One non-certified staff member
7. Board and community members shall be appointed by the Board President.
8. The administrator and staff members shall be selected by the District Administrator.
9. Assigned staff members shall be paid \$30.00 per meeting plus mileage. Staff members shall not be paid if the committee meeting takes place during the working hours.
10. Ad hoc committee members shall be paid \$30.00 per meeting.

#### Parent Advisory Committees

1. Parent advisory committee members shall be elected or appointed to conform to program regulations.
2. Parent advisory committee members shall be paid \$30.00 per meeting plus mileage, except as otherwise specified.

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3. Building administrators shall attend parent advisory meetings whenever possible, especially those meetings involving needs assessment and review of the program application.
