PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

The process of education shall be a joint responsibility of the Board, administration, staff, parents, students, and other citizens of the District.

Anyone who wants to appear before the Board shall notify the District Administrator in writing, giving the reason, prior to the distribution of the agenda. The District Administrator shall place the matter on the agenda of the next regular meeting and include any available materials relating to the matter in the board packet.

Citizens may address the Board at regular meetings at that point on the agenda designated for "Comments from Visitors". A time limit of no more than three minutes will be allowed per citizen. The Board may discuss matters raised by the public during this portion of the meeting, but the Board shall not act on such matters unless topics are specifically listed on the printed agenda for the meeting.
