BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The program of instruction in the elementary school shall include: (a) language arts; (b) reading; (c) social studies; (d) mathematics; (e) science; (f) physical education; (g) health; (h) music; (i) arts and crafts; (j) career education; (k) conservation of natural resources; (l) computer literacy; and (m) Menominee language and culture.

The middle school shall provide instruction in each of the subject fields listed for elementary school and other elective offerings relevant to the mission of the schools.

The high school shall offer work in each of the subject fields listed for middle school, but in each field there shall be a greater variety of courses and more specialized instruction. The specific courses shall include instruction in college preparation, general education, and vocational training programs, and be approved by the Board of Education.

Whenever practical, the community resources shall be incorporated into the curriculum.

In all instances, the District curriculum shall meet the educational requirements established by state laws and regulations.
