342.2-Rule

TITLE I PARENT INVOLVEMENT GUIDELINES

The Board, in accordance with federal regulations governing Title I and NCLB, shall convene annually a public meeting to explain the Title I program and to allow parent/guardians of Title I eligible students input into the Title I activities. All parents/guardians shall be notified by the district and encouraged to attend. Election of Title I officers will also take place at this meeting.

The Board shall make further assurances that the District will support activities that foster continued involvement. The District will engage and support the following activities:

1. After children eligible for Title I services have been identified, parents/guardians of these students will receive information about the Title I program, its purpose, alignment to the curriculum and a over-view of Federal and State guidelines.
2. Prior to the start of instruction each parent/guardian will be requested to sign a letter of permission to participate in the Title I program.
3. A parent/guardian compact will be sent home and the parent/guardian will be asked to sign and return it. This compact will also be signed by the student and teacher. Compacts will monitored and reviewed during parent/guardian conferences. (see attached copy of compact).
4. Each parent/guardian will be invited to two conferences yearly, one in the Fall and one in the Spring, with the classroom teacher and Title I teacher. Other conferences may be held as needed or by request.
5. Parent/guardians will be provided with materials and suggestions for reading and mathematics to help them promote the education of their children at home.
6. Weekly newsletters will be sent home to parents/guardians informing them of upcoming Title I events and activities.

7. Monthly family fun nights/meetings will be held for all students receiving Title services. These events will focus on educational issues and instructional activities for parents/guardians.
8. Parents will be informed of an open door policy for all instruction involving their child.
9. Monthly informal meetings will be held with Title I elected officers and parent/guardians to solicit in-put and suggestions in the planning, development and operation of the Title I program.
10. The district will provide on-going information to parents/guardians on how the school and staff can work with them to achieve the program's objectives.
