GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM

The Menominee Indian School District shall provide access, without charge for tuition, to appropriate programs for gifted and talented students.

Students shall be identified in the following five areas of giftedness: intellectual, academic, leadership, creative and artistic. Students shall be identified using multiple criteria that are appropriate for the category, in accordance with established procedures and consistent with state law and regulations.

The District shall, with Board and District Administrator approval, cover cost of tuition, text and supplies for a student identified as gifted and talented to attend appropriate higher education courses if the District cannot meet the student's needs through regular classroom instruction. Students in 11th and 12th grade may also participate in the youth options program in accordance with state law and regulations.
