343.3-Rule

GUIDELINES FOR INDEPENDENT STUDY

1. In order to receive elective credit for independent study courses, the work involved must closely approximate the number of hours required for regular curriculum credit courses.
2. The following process shall be used to grant elective credit for independent study:
 - a. Except under unusual circumstances (that would need the approval of the director of curriculum), independent study offerings must be submitted to the high school principal by May 15th for approval for the following school year.
 - b. All independent study proposals shall contain the following:
 1. an outline of the course;
 2. listed goals and objectives for expected outcomes at course completion; and
 3. a list of typical assignments/projects.
3. Independent study course outlines shall be kept on file in the guidance office.
4. There must be a minimum of one meeting per week with the teacher assigned to the independent study.
