ADULT EDUCATION

The Board of Education recognizes the general objectives of adult education. Recommendations for adult education programs shall be made through the prescribed lines of authority and shall be approved by the Board.

The physical facilities of the District may be contracted for other educational programs when there is no conflict with regular school activities.

Adults who have not completed the District's graduation requirements may pursue their diploma using several alternatives:

1. Full or part-time attendance in classes during the regular school day where space in the classes permits.
2. Successful completion of coursework from a recognized educational institution.
3. Independent courses of study offered in the Menominee Indian School District as determined appropriate by the high school principal and designated course instructor.
