GRADING SYSTEM

It shall be the policy of the District to evaluate student achievement in grades kindergarten through 12. The issuance of grades on a regular basis serves to:

- a. promote a process of continuous evaluation of student performance;
- b. inform the student and his/her parent(s)/guardian of the student's progress;
- c. provide a basis for bringing about change in student performance if such change is deemed necessary.

Specific grading systems shall be developed for various grade levels by the building principal with input from staff.

The District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This does not, however, prohibit the use of special testing or counseling materials or techniques to meet the individualized needs of students. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
