GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate from Menominee Indian High School, a student shall meet the following requirements:

1. Earn 24 course credits, as follows:

English	4	credits
Science	3	credits
Social Studies	4	credits
Math	3	credits
Physical Education	1.5	credits
Fine Arts*	.5	credits
Applied Arts**	.5	credits
Electives	7	credits
Health	.5	credits
Total	24	credits

* Fine Arts = All music and art courses

** Applied Arts = All home economics, business, and applied technology courses

In all instances these requirements shall meet or exceed the standards established by state laws and regulations.

The District shall allow granting and acceptance of $\frac{1}{4}$ credits to transferring students.

2. Be enrolled in a class or participating in a Board-approved activity during each class period of each school day while attending high school.
3. Attend high school for four years, except as otherwise approved.

The District may provide accommodations for students with exceptional interests, needs or requirements.

Students who have successfully completed graduation requirements shall be granted diplomas
