Purpose

The availability of Internet access in the Menomonie Indian School District provides an educational opportunity for both students and staff to contribute to the World Wide Web through the District's web page. The purpose of the MISD web page is to provide information about the District schools and to view on-line projects and student work. The following may be included on the web site: traditional addresses of the schools, email addresses of the staff, phone numbers, pictures of the schools, calendars, mission statements, schedules, curriculum, handbooks, favorite links, administrative messages, teacher pages, and student work.

Content and Technical Standards

Content and technical standards shall be maintained consistent with established guidelines.

Structure

Ultimately, the school administrators are responsible for their web pages; however, the District Administrator and principals may appoint a person from their facility to manage submitted material. All web pages must be edited, tested for accurate links, and meet the established content standards. A District web master shall be appointed by the technology committee. The web master shall recruit a committee of three, one from each building, to help make decisions about procedures, technical standards, style, and content. Students submitting pages must have a sponsoring teacher.

This policy and the accompanying guidelines shall be evaluated and updated in response to the changing nature of technology in the District.
