EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Board of Education recognizes that extracurricular activities are vital to the complete development of the student. All organizations and activities sponsored by the District shall:

1. provide educational opportunities for additional teaching and learning; and
2. meet basic educational criteria established by the professional and administrative staff.

Any organization or activity that does not meet the educational objectives and philosophy of the District shall be suspended upon recommendations of the administration and subject to board approval.

All full-time students within each building are eligible to participate in student organizations and activities of that building. Minimum eligibility requirements shall be established for organizations or activities by the building principal with Board approval.

The Board shall encourage the full participation of elementary, middle school, and high school students in extracurricular and recreational programs and activities.

The District shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This policy does not, however, prohibit the district from placing a student in an activity based on objective standards of performance. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
