RECYCLING

The Board of Education shall encourage and support recycling of all used materials whenever possible in order to conserve our natural resources.

The maintenance supervisor shall be responsible for an ongoing recycling plan of action. As such, annually, a committee made up of a representation of building principals, curriculum office, director of transportation, facilities and energy manager and central stores/purchasing agent will meet to review the adequacy of current recycling procedures and to implement any new areas of recycling either mandated by state law or locally permissible.

A student orientation shall be held the first week of each school year to inform students of the recycling program, including how to identify the materials to be recycled and where and how to recycle such materials.
