STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The Board of Education shall establish policies and procedures governing student transportation that comply with state laws and regulations. The Board shall delegate this responsibility to the District Administrator, who may delegate the supervision and operation to the transportation supervisor.

The transportation supervisor shall approve all bus routes and act as liaison between the Board and District Administrator. He/she shall also recommend to the Board any changes deemed necessary in any existing transportation policy or any addition necessary in such policy.

All students in grades kindergarten through 12 who reside in the Menominee Indian School District shall be transported under the following conditions:

1. Students residing two miles or more from their assigned school.
2. Where hazardous conditions require transportation.
3. Students with disabilities in accordance with their individualized education programs (IEPs).
(Nonresident students who are attending District schools under the public school open enrollment program shall also be transported, if required by their IEPs).

Students will be transported to the nearest public or private school they are eligible to attend. In cases where it is not feasible to provide transportation by bus, parent transportation contracts may be arranged in accordance with state law and regulations.
