STUDENT TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Hazardous Areas

A. Students in grades kindergarten through three who reside in hazardous areas less than two miles from the school they attend shall be provided transportation due to the following conditions:

1. Lack of sidewalks;
2. Lack of adequate shoulders;
3. Major highway (Highway 47-55) must be crossed;
4. Community does not provide crossing guards;
5. Traffic patterns that are present at the beginning and end of the day; and
6. Age of the students affected.

B. Areas identified as hazardous include the following:

1. Pine Ridge/Commot Lane
2. Schoolview
3. Warrington Addition
4. Highway 47-55 South to Line

Students with Disabilities

- a. Any student requiring any special transportation must be evaluated by the individualized education program (IEP) team prior to the authorization of any special transportation. An IEP will be on file with the transportation supervisor.
- b. Students with disabilities will be transported on regular buses if they are able to get on and off the bus with little or no assistance and if they do not require any special care while aboard the bus.
- c. All special buses used for transportation of students with disabilities who do not qualify for service on regular buses shall meet all legal requirements.
