SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS GOALS

The Board of Education believes two-way communication between the school system and the public it serves is essential for the maintenance and growth of a progressive program of public education. Such communication serves to stimulate a better understanding of the role, objectives, accomplishments, and needs of the educational program while at the same time allowing public participation in the determination of directional policy.

The Board shall regularly involve the public and all District employees in the development of all District policies, plans, and programs. The Board shall also develop a means to regularly inform all the internal and external public of these policies, plans, and programs. These shall include:

1. plans for financial needs;
2. the status of building maintenance and future physical plan needs;
3. the status of the students' educational needs and attainment;
4. the educational curriculum and curriculum development activities;
5. the importance and benefits of the educational program for both the community and society; and
6. the availability of school facilities for use by civic organizations and organized individual activities.

The Board recognizes its obligation to inform the public of its actions, policies, and educational and business operations. The Board will utilize the news media (newspapers, radio, television), school newsletters, school/community groups, and other appropriate mechanisms to inform the public. In addition, the Board will endeavor to work closely with the various active community organizations and regularly inform their members of school activities.

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
