PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS/PROMOTIONS ON SCHOOL PREMISES

Educational facilities, District Staff, or students shall not be used in any manner for the promotions or sales campaigns of services or products (e.g. financial, educational, charitable, or for outside agencies or organizations operating for profit), except as otherwise permitted by Board of Education policy.

Where the Board and the District Administrator feel that the educational gain outweighs any promotional purposes, prior approval may be given by the Board to any activity. Participation by students in charity activities is considered to be a desirable part of their total education. The Board will authorize the administration to determine the nature and extent of such activity.

The Board specifically forbids such activities as the following:

1. Distribution by students of pamphlets urging students, parents/guardians, and others to purchase services or products sold for profit.
2. The sale by students or District staff of products and/or services, except in relation to production by students as part of the program.
3. Similar activities which would involve the District staff and students and which would interfere with the normal time and activities of the school.

No person or persons shall be permitted to solicit any District student or staff for any purpose, or distribute circulars, handbills, cards, or take up contributions in any school building or on the premises, for any purpose whatsoever, except by approval from the District Administrator as being in accord with the approved procedures.
