TRESPASSING ON SCHOOL DISTRICT LAND

No unauthorized person may enter or remain on land owned by the Menominee Indian School District between one hour after sunset on one day and one hour before sunrise on the next day. A sign at least 11 inches square shall be placed in at least two conspicuous places for every 40 acres of land to be protected. Such signs shall carry an appropriate notice of the intent of this policy followed by "Menominee Indian School District Owner".

Persons of the following classes are deemed authorized and may enter and remain on said land under the conditions described below:

1. District officers and employees engaged in District business.
2. Law enforcement officers, including auxiliary officers and fire fighting personnel while in performance of their duties.
3. Persons attending school functions, except students who have lost this privilege due to suspension or expulsion from the District. Any school employees or officials are responsible for enforcing this policy.
4. Parents/guardians who have reason to believe that their minor child is on said land.
5. Persons granted permission to enter by the Board of Education.
6. Persons using lighted play areas.

This policy shall be published as a Class 1 notice in the official newspaper of the Menominee Reservation. A copy of the policy shall be sent to the Chief of Police of the Menominee Reservation.
