421-Rule(2)

EARLY KINDERGARTEN ADMISSION PROCEDURES

The following procedures will be followed for any requests for early admission to kindergarten:

1. The request for early admission to kindergarten form must be completely filled out by the school submitting a request for testing/early admission to kindergarten.
2. The completed form is then submitted to special education department/school psychologist and District Administrator's office.
3. Parent(s)/guardian and school psychologist then discuss the screening information in the form and decide if parent(s)/guardian wants to continue early admission procedures.
4. If there is any evaluation, the psychologist may ask other evaluators/student service worker to submit reports (e.g., attendance report; physical evaluation).
5. If any evaluation is conducted, the parent/guardian conference will include the student's teacher from the previous year, other evaluators or report writers for the student as well as the parent(s)/guardian, school psychologist, principal and special education director.
6. The Board of Education shall have final authority in deciding whether or not the child is to have early admission to kindergarten.
