STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

The school bus driver is recognized as having the same jurisdiction over the children while enroute to school as a teacher in a classroom. Therefore, the driver shall maintain order among the children at all times when they are being transported to and from school.

Continued disorderly conduct or refusal to submit to the authority of the driver shall be sufficient reason for refusing transportation service to any student. When it becomes necessary to refuse to transport a student due to misconduct, the transportation supervisor or his/her designee shall make the decision and shall notify the parent/guardian of such refusal with a full explanation for this action. When students are denied transportation for disciplinary reasons, parents/guardians are responsible for transporting them to and from school.

Pertinent information relative to student transportation such as Board policies, bus route schedules and bus rider rules shall be distributed to each parent/guardian at the beginning of the school. This information shall also be sent as the need arises during the school year.
