443.5 Rule

GUIDELINES FOR CELL PHONES, IPODS, MP3 PLAYERS AND OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN SCHOOLS

Definition: The term Electronic Device (ED) shall apply to cell phones, pagers, IPODS, MP3 Players, PDA's and other devices that receive and/or transmit an electromagnetic signal.

- 1. Cell phones are not allowed during the school day.
- 2. Cell phone use should be limited to emergency situations.
- 3. Cell phones may not be used and must be powered off (not on silent or vibrate) when student is in the classroom or during school-sponsored activities during the regular instructional day, such as school assemblies.
- 4. An Ed that disrupts class, an assembly or is used during passing periods will be confiscated and only returned after a meeting with the 1)student, and 2)parent/guardian.
- 5. IPOD's, MP3 players and similar electronic devices may not be used in class unless it is part of a class assignment or at the discretion of the teacher.
- 6. Menominee Indian School District does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen ED's.
