DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES

The following continuum of consequences has been established for the purpose of student discipline:

- Verbal warning
- meeting with teacher outside class time
- meeting with teacher and administrator
- meeting with parent, teacher, administrator
- assignment to noon lunch detention
- assignment to after school detention
- assignment to Saturday morning intervention
- assignment to in-school suspension
- assignment to out of school suspension

Saturday Morning Intervention

Saturday morning intervention reflects two different philosophies. It is intended to:

- Provide one more opportunity for students who have not completed consequences for their behavior to do so before suspension becomes an issue; and
- provide an opportunity for students who are behind in their classes to get caught up.

Students who cannot attend Saturday morning intervention shall be assigned to in-school suspension the next day they come to school.
