

STUDENT DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

A student may be brought before the superintendent for a Pre-expulsion conference to explain her/his behavior if he/she engages in willful, chronic, and/or disruptive behavior.

The purpose of the conference is to accomplish the following:

1. To review the events leading up to the administration's recommendation for expulsion.
2. To listen to the student/parent/guardian's view of the circumstances leading up to suspension.
3. To determine whether the facts relevant to this case confirm that the student:

Engaged in conduct while at school or while under the supervision of school authority which endangered the property, health or safety of others (i.e. drugs, alcohol).

Or engaged in conduct while not at school or while not under the supervision of a school authority which endangered the property, health or safety of others at school or under the supervision of a school authority.

Or endangered the property, health or safety of any employee or school board member of the school district in which the pupils is enrolled.

Or engaged in conduct of repeated refusal or neglect to obey rules.

Or knowingly conveyed or caused to be conveyed any threat or false information concerning an attempt or alleged attempt being made or to be made to destroy any school property by means of explosives.

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Or possessed a firearm while at school or while under the supervision of a school authority.

And that the interest of the school demands suspension.

Wis. State Statutes 120.13(1)(c)

4. To develop an intervention plan which will assist the student in avoiding expulsion in the near future if it is not in the interest of the school to demand expulsion.
5. A certified letter will be sent to the student and parent/guardian requiring them to attend this meeting.
