AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (AED)

The Menominee Indian School District shall place an automatic external defibrillator (AED) in each of its four school buildings. The AEDs are for use in emergency medical situations involving pulseless, non-breathing victims, where the security of the facility will not be compromised and the safety of individuals will not be endangered.

The AED may be utilized by staff that have a cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and AED certification. All of the school nurses will maintain an updated list of trained staff.

Use of the AEDs shall be in accordance with established procedures.
