STUDENT IMMUNIZATIONS

It shall be the policy of the Menominee Indian School District to require students in 4K through grade 12, including transfer students, to have all required immunizations as mandated by state law. Except as otherwise provided, immunizations shall be required for measles, mumps, rubella, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), tetanus, polio, hepatitis B and varicella, in accordance with state law and regulations.

A student may be waived from the immunization requirements only if a parent/guardian submits a written statement or a properly signed waiver form which objects to the immunizations for reasons of health, religion or personal conviction.

Students are required to present written evidence of immunizations or a written waiver within the time period outlined by law.

In cooperation with public health agencies and officials, the Board shall develop and implement a plan to encourage compliance with state student immunization requirements. The plan shall be submitted to the appropriate state agency as required by law.
