ALBUTEROL MDI ADMINISTRATION

The Menominee Indian School District shall keep a supply of albuterol metered dose inhaler (MDI) in a locked cabinet in the nurse's room. It shall be available as follows:

1. For students diagnosed with asthma.
 - a. These students must have a medication authorization form completed by a doctor and submitted to the school nurse.
 - b. For emergency situations with students having asthma symptoms (severe shortness of breath, difficulty breathing and/or audible wheezing) and who do not possess their own individual inhaler. The nurse will assess the student for asthma symptoms. The parent and/or emergency medical technicians will be called for follow-up if necessary.

The medication will be prescribed annually by the District's medical consultant and replaced on expired dates. It will be used according to the physician's instructions. The nurse and designated staff will be trained annually on how to administer the MDI.
