STUDENT SUDDEN DEATH PLAN

The Menominee Community is painfully aware that sudden death among our youth is a growing crisis. This has created a concern about suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention. It is critical that all school and community staff be prepared to respond appropriately to a threatened, attempted, or completed suicide.

The Board of Education has established procedures to deal with "sudden death" issues within the District.

In addition, a school/community response plan has been developed to facilitate a coordinated approach to suicide prevention and intervention and reaction to a crisis.
