KINDERGARTEN PROMOTION CEREMONY

All children who are progressing from kindergarten into the first grade the following fall will participate in the kindergarten promotion ceremony. The children who are being retained in kindergarten will be promoted the following year.

The Board of Education policy committee recommends an afternoon program. The program will consist of finger plays and songs done by the children. The children may receive kindergarten diplomas and wear their paper promotion ceremony hats and corsages.

Kindergarten students will not attend classes on the day of graduation to allow staff to prepare for the kindergarten promotion ceremony.

The kindergarten promotion ceremony marks the end of the kindergarten year and kindergarten students will not return to classes after the ceremony.
