

MENOMINEE INDIAN SCHOOL DISTRICT

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SCHOOL BOARD POWERS AND DUTIES

The Board shall serve as the legislative governing body of the District. Administrative activities shall be performed by the District Administrator and his/her staff. Functions of the Board can be described as policymaking, decision-making, appraisal, and evaluation.

The Board shall:

1. Oversee the financial means by which the educational operation, and maintenance and building programs are conducted.
2. Ensure that the community is informed of the needs, purposes, values, and status of the schools.
3. Hire qualified administrative staff.
4. Perform the specific duties outlined by state law.

In addition, the Board may exercise the specific powers permitted by state law and may do all things reasonable to promote the cause of education, including establishing, providing and improving District programs, functions and activities for the benefit of students.
