The purpose of the fair was to introduce students to a number of vendors and services around the state that they may utilize now and after

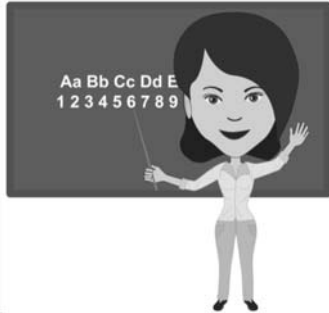
high school. Vendors included law enforcement and resource protection; healthcare, banking and financial services; regional public transportation; and an array of educational institutions.

MISD will pay for training and licensing for substitute teachers

MISD has launched a recruiting effort for substitute teachers. “Like many districts throughout the state, we can always use the services of additional substitute teachers,” explained MISD Superintendent Wendell Waukau. “And, with the current labor shortage, we decided to be proactive in our recruitment efforts.”

As part of the initiative, the District will pay for training and the cost of Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (WDPI) substitute

teacher licensing.

“We want to make it easy for people interested in substitute teaching to get the training and licensing they need,” explained Waukau. “Teaching is a very rewarding career, but not everyone wants to work fulltime. For those interested in teaching on a part-time basis, substitute teaching could be a great fit for them.”

Requirements include:

- Possessing an associate or bachelor’s degree

- Attending a one-day training through CESA 6 in Oshkosh. A variety of dates are available. Training is held from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Must agree to a one-year commitment to substitute teach at MISD
