The Menominee Indian Tribe and the Menominee Indian School District (MISD) are recognized at the state and national level for improving educational and public health outcomes by increasing their understanding of historical trauma, childhood adversity, and by developing culturally relevant practices. Based on our continuous improvement journey, MISD has a full time position available as a School Counselor at the Keshena Primary School (KPS) for the 2019-20 school year. The over-all goal of this position is to enhance the social and emotional well-being of children in the District's 4K-5 classes as a part of the District's Trauma Responsive Schools initiative that works in partnership with our Tribal community.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidate shall possess a DPI certified School Counselor certification. Experience working with at-risk populations is highly recommended.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Successful experience providing mental health and/or behavioral support with school aged children. Experience in crisis intervention and counseling. Experience working with children exposed to trauma.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide classroom guidance 4K-5 in the area of social emotional learning (SEL). Collaborate with building staff to establish and maintain a positive mental health and behavioral culture in the school, communicate effectively with families particularly as related to challenging student circumstance and issues, work closely with grade level, student services, and leadership teams in using data to plan interventions, programming and advancing district initiatives, work collaboratively with community agencies on the current trauma informed practices, perform such other duties as may be determined by the administrative staff within parameters of the master agreement, Board of Education policies, state statutes and administrative rules, willing to be trained in Youth Mental Health First Aid, Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES), Trauma Smart, Historical Trauma, & Restorative Practices.
