QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidate shall possess a Technology Education certification from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI).

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

The PLO (Personalized Learning Options) Technology Education Teacher will work with the PLO team to develop projects that incorporate the learning goals in the core course and expand student job skills. This will incorporate welding, woodworking, electrical wiring, and work in the aquaponics greenhouse. When not working directly with the PLO roughly 2 periods a day, this teacher will be used to expand our technology education course offerings.
