Registration Matters!

Registration for all MISD students (4K-12) now takes place online; and it will take place annually.

Since it is totally an online process, there will not be any paper forms. But, if you're not tech savvy, don't worry. Each school

will host Open Houses (for walk-in registration) if you need assistance.

If your child is already registered and attending MISD, you'll need to review their registration annually. If your student is new to

MISD, you'll have to visit the school they'll be attending during school office hours to fill out a transcript request form prior to being able to enroll.
