QUALIFICATIONS: Candidate shall possess the proper certification from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI). In the event a certified person is unavailable, the candidate shall possess a minimum of a high school diploma or its equivalent.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Only certified persons in Wisconsin shall be assigned as coaches. If a certified instructor is unavailable, an emergency status will be recognized by the WIAA. Anyone non-certified must be willing to complete a ASEP class. The ideal candidate must have an understanding of fundamentals and game strategies relating to the sports indicated. Experience in coaching is preferred.
