**Subject: Strategic Planning Committee Recommendation Process for 2013-2014 Budget Augmentation**

During the development of the fiscal year 2013-2014 budget, the Strategic Planning Committee (SPC) took steps to mature its process for recommending new/augmented budgets to the President. This memo seeks to describe that process and the associated criteria analysis matrix (CAM) the process created.

Annual Program Reviews (APRs) and budgets were received and collated by the Office of Research and Planning in October/November 2012. In November, APR binders - with all budget requests - were delivered to the SPC and Budget Committee memberships.

Administrators for Student Services, Instruction, and Administration developed summary statements of the APRs for their respective areas. The SPC membership split into two-person teams with the purpose of reading and summarizing a selection of APRs from outside the program they work in. Program APRs were discussed at SPC meetings and thoughts were exchanged by the entire committee regarding the APR summaries.

In order to recommend budget increases to the President, it became apparent that a prioritization would be necessary. A CAM was developed by the SPC to facilitate the prioritization. Each criterion was graded with a maximum score of 5 and a minimum score of 1. Budget augmentations with a greater score were deemed to have a greater priority. Budget augmentations of similar types were grouped together, i.e. student travel for all programs and sports were grouped into a single item. In an effort to minimize bias, the two-person teams who summarized each APR (with the assistance of Brian Murphy to encourage consistency in scoring) initially determined the scores. The criteria that follow were given equal weight in the prioritization:

- Augmentation budget impact – Budget impact based on a percentage of the base budget. Values were assigned as follows (5 for less than .05%, 4 for less than .1%, 3 for less than .25%, 2 for less than .50%, 1 for more than 1% of last year's GF budget)
- Uncontrollable augmentation – The SPC membership decided the controllability of the augmentation (a fully uncontrollable augmentation such as a utilities increase was awarded a 5 while a controllable augmentation such as increasing a program's professional development budget was awarded a 1)
- Ongoing cost – A cost that would continue into the future was given a negative rating while a cost that was onetime (5 for onetime, 3 for once every five years, 1 for every year)

- Safety/Risk – The ability of the augmentation to reduce district exposure to hazards (5 for high likelihood and high exposure; 3 for either or; 1 for low likelihood and low exposure)
- Student attraction – The ability of the augmentation to bring new students to the district (5 highly likely to attract a significant number of new students; 3 likely to attract significant number of new students or highly likely to attract some new students; 1 unlikely to attract new students)
- Student retention – The ability of the augmentation to retain current students (5 for highly likely to retain students, 3 for moderately likely to retain students, 1 for no impact)
- Feasibility - A measure of the difficulty associated with implementing the activity supported by the augmentation (5 for will be implemented quickly if funded, 3 for likely to implemented but requires multiple departments, 1 for the district has never done anything like this before)

Using these criteria, 42 augmentations were prioritized and received scores. The prioritized list was discussed in meetings and items were adjusted as necessary to reach consensus. The finalized list was forwarded to the President. The President sent the final list to the Budget Committee on March 26 for their consideration.

In final preparation of the 2013-2014 Budget, the President included the top four ranked items, as well as two additional lower-ranked items that were relatively low-cost and directly related to classroom instruction. As a result of the SPC process and recommendations to the President, the following six items are included in the 2013-2014 Budget that is being sent to the FRCCD Board of Trustees.

**Re:** Budget Recommendations for 2013-14 Funding Through APR Process

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Attached are the recommendations from the Strategic Planning Committee for funding, should money be available in the creation of the 2013-14 FRC budget. This prioritized list is a result of the APR process and Strategic Planning Committee discussions. At this point, only these items are being recommended for funding, and all other items from the APR process are not being recommended due to the large dollar amount of the requests submitted.

While the Strategic Planning Committee realizes that there may not be additional revenue in the 2013-14 budget for the purchase of equipment or supplies, this is our best attempt at prioritizing the equipment and supplies that we feel should be funded and included in the budget development should funding be available.

This list was developed through the following process:

- 1) All APR requests were reviewed by sub-committees of the Strategic Planning Committee
- 2) A preliminary criteria analysis matrix (CAM) analysis and ranking was developed by the Strategic Planning Committee
- 3) This led to further discussions and movement for a secondary ranking of the requests
- 4) **The President used a “red line” to change certain items due to circumstances unknown to the SPC.** This was discussed with the SPC and the final list was developed.
- 5) The following factors were considered when ranking all APR requests:
  - budget impact,
  - uncontrollable aspects of the request (-e.g., increases in postage rates),
  - was the request ongoing or one-time,
  - safety issues,
  - was the request likely to attract new or additional students,
  - would the request improve student retention/success,
  - what was the overall feasibility of the request given our existing infrastructure and staffing levels, and
  - the operational realities of the request.

SUBJECT: Budget Committee Recommendations for the 2013-14 Fiscal Year  
Final Budget

The Budget Committee met on Friday, August 23, 2013, to finalize their recommendation of the 2013/2014 Proposed Final Budget. The following items were adjusted using the 2013/2014 Adopted Tentative Budget as the base budget:

- 1) Increased unrestricted general fund revenue:
  - a) Increased Full Time Equivalent Students (FTES) by 53 which represents an increase of \$229,341 which includes both credit and non-credit FTES.
  - b) Increased apportionment funding by 1.57% due to cost of living adjustment (COLA), which is estimated at approximately \$174,085.
  - c) Recognized \$2,000 in anticipated revenue generated from the Spring Drama production.
- 2) Decreased expenditures by \$30,600 due to the elimination of expenditures related to the Administrative Search which was carried over from the previous year.
- 3) Increased expenditures based on the COLA increase of 1.57%:
  - a) Resulting Increase in Salaries/Academic of \$45,981
  - b) Increase in Salaries/Classified by \$38,264
  - c) Increase of Payroll Benefits related to the salary increases based on the COLA increase which represents \$44,719.
- 4) Increased Drama – Instructional Supplies due to the recognized revenue mentioned above (1c) by \$2,000.
- 5) Based on the Strategic Planning Committee's list of prioritized APR funding requests for consideration - the following six expense items were included:
  - a) ISP Postage increase of \$1,700
  - b) ORL Permits increase of \$141
  - c) Facilities increased totaling \$5,120
  - d) Credit Card processing fees increase of \$14,216
  - e) Biology equipment maintenance increase of \$1,000
  - f) Drama Facility Rental and related expenses was increased by \$930
- 6) Academic Administration requested an additional \$144,375 to assist in the enrollment stability of the District. This would help increase FTES by 100 Full Time

Equivalent Students. This request was included in the 2013/2014 Proposed Final Budget.

- 7) The remaining funds of \$137,580 were put into a Contingency Appropriation account whereby the exact use of these funds could be determined at a later date as needs were identified and unexpected shortfalls were realized.

It is the unanimous recommendation of the Budget Committee to request your positive consideration, the above adjustments which are incorporated into the 2013/14 Proposed Final Budget request.

## **REVENUE DEFINITIONS**

**GENERAL REVENUES:** A combination of State apportionment, property tax revenues and student enrollment fees. General revenue is calculated by formula contained in State Law. Prior year general revenues may be increased by State cost of living adjustments, FTES (full time equivalent students) growth, and program improvement funds and decreased by FTES decline. Property tax revenues and student enrollment fees are deducted from the "total computational revenue" calculations in determining State apportionments.

**FOREST REVENUES:** The proceeds from logging and grazing activities on Federal forest land which are apportioned to schools through the County Superintendent of Education and "Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000" funds.

**LOTTERY:** Community college share of State lottery revenues.

**INTEREST:** Interest paid on District funds in Plumas County Treasury.

**HEALTH FEES:** Student fees charged to offset a portion of the cost of student accident insurance and college nurse services.

**OUT-OF-STATE TUITION:** Enrollment fees charged to students from other states, except for "Good-Neighbor" Students from Nevada.

**OTHER STATE REVENUES:**

**Part-time Faculty Compensation:** Funds provided by the State of California to allow districts to make progress towards comparable pay for part-time faculty.

**Mandated Costs:** Reimbursements received from the State for a portion of the costs of mandated activities (Example: collective bargaining costs).

**LOCAL REVENUES:** Revenues received from local sources such as from rental of facilities, admission to drama productions and summer sport camp fees.

**INTRA-FUND INCOMING TRANSFER/TRIO:** Transfer within General Fund from the Restricted Fund's Trio Grant to the Unrestricted Fund for reimbursement of salary and fringe expenses.

**BEGINNING FUND BALANCE:** Net projected balance of prior year's revenues in excess of expenditures. Also referred to as contingency and reserves.

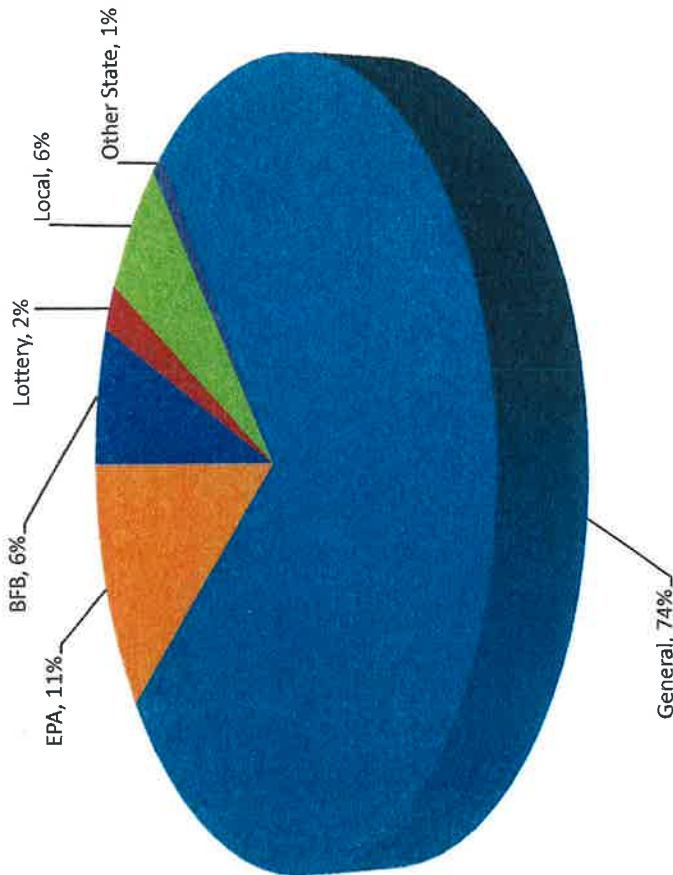

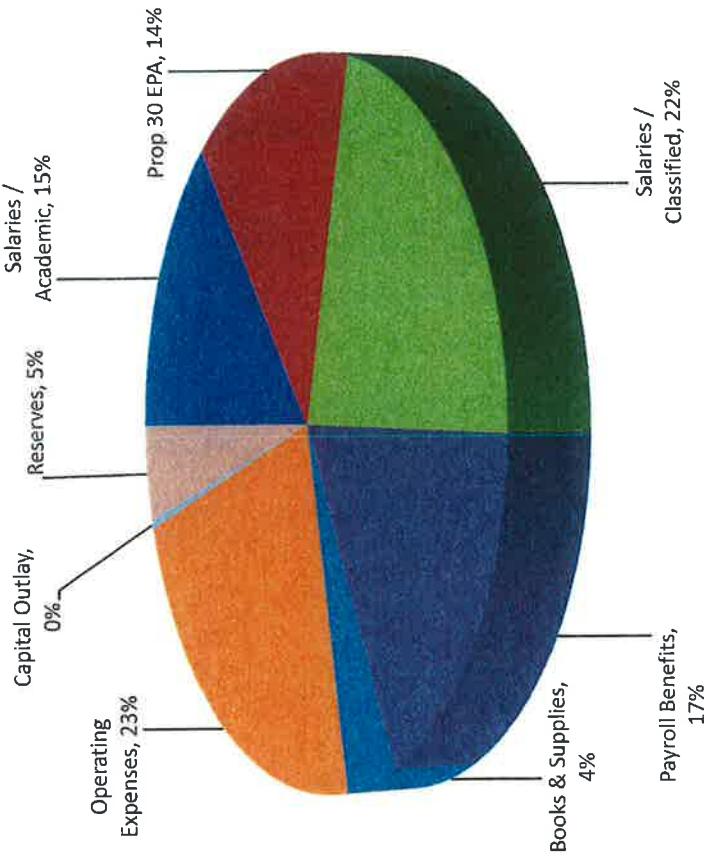
