



If you have been selected for verification and have amended your **2016** federal tax return, there are additional documents that must be submitted. For our office to complete the financial aid verification process please **submit the following:**

1. An IRS Tax Return Transcript (that will only include information from the original tax return and that does not have to be signed),

**AND**

2. A **signed** copy of the **2016** IRS Form 1040X, “Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return” that was filed with the IRS.

**How to request your 2016 Tax Return Transcripts from the IRS**

From the [IRS website](#), you can request a tax return transcript through their Get Transcript [Online](#) or Get Transcript by [Mail](#) options. You can also contact the IRS by phone to request your tax return transcript. **Note:** *the method you used to file your return and whether you have a refund or balance due, affects your [current year transcript availability](#).*

**Notice:** Be sure to request an **IRS Tax Return Transcript** – **not** an IRS Tax Account Transcript.
