



As you may know, the 2016-17 *and* 2017-18 FAFSA applications **BOTH** use tax information from the **2015** tax year. Your 2016-17 and 2017-18 FAFSA applications were compared for conflicting tax information by the Department of Education’s Central Processing System.

Both your 2016-17 and 2017-18 FAFSA applications have been flagged due to **conflicting tax information between the two applications**.

As a result, you **must** go into each application to correct the tax information to insure both applications accurately reflect yours and/or your parent’s (if applicable) **2015** taxes. If you need assistance, please bring yours and your parent’s (if applicable) 2015 taxes and come into the office. This is the best way we can assist you in updating the information.

NOTE:** Until the conflicting information has been resolved, Feather River College is **unable** to disburse any 2016-17 OR 2017-18 Title IV Federal Student Aid (Financial Aid). In the event the conflicting information is **NOT RESOLVED**, Feather River College must consider you (the student) to be in an overaward status for any need-based 2016-17 Title IV Aid that was disburse. **This could result in you owing the college money.
