Student Trustee

Attends all meetings of the College's Board of Trustees (except closed session) and presents information regarding student activities to the Board

Votes on behalf of the student body

Receives a \$50 stipend per meeting

Represents FRC students in the community

President

Serves as executive officer and representative of the students of FRC

Leads ASFRC meetings and attends some college meetings

Prepares the agenda for meetings

Attends community activities for public relations purposes

Vice President

Fulfills the President's duties if for any reason the president is unable to

Maintains a resource file and calendar of activities

Secretary/Treasurer

Prepares and posts agendas, minutes and other necessary paperwork in accordance with Brown Act

Prepares official correspondence for the student government if/when necessary

Assists with the development and management of a budget
