

Summary of Veterinary Finding from Examinations on May 15 and 16, 2019

As of Thursday May 16th, 24 of the 2019 Feather River College horses were designation “clear to sell” by Dr. Tanya Balaam of Large Animal Veterinary Services. There are several disclaimers that buyers should be aware of including the following:

Lot #1 FRC Dream Till Sunday (Tilly) is “clear to sell” but has a one tooth width incisor overbite.

Lot #3 FRC Ill Be Tiger (Tiger) is “clear to sell” but was designated a Grade 1/5 on the lameness scale on the left front when trotted on hard ground. No significant findings on radiographic evaluation. X rays available upon request.

Lot #7 FRC MissSilver Pearl (Pearl) is “clear to sell” but was designated a Grade 1/5 on the lameness scale on the right front and left front when trotted on hard ground but negative to the hoof-testers on both front hooves. Toed in conformation with paddling at the trot in front.

Lot #10 FRC Peppy Lil Mouse (Mouse) is “clear to sell” but has a firm scar on right hock.

Lot #13 FRC Quick Play Jose (Jose) is “clear to sell” but is missing an incisor.

Lot #15 FRC Shiney Playgun (Taquito) is “clear to sell” but has a one tooth width overbite.

Lot #17 FRC Smart Lil Champ (Champ) is “clear to sell” but is missing lateral 1/3 eyelid margin.

Lot #18 FRC Sparklnshinelira (Lira) is “clear to sell” but her mouth was not examined due to resistance.

Lot #19 FRC Stoppin On A Dime (Dime) is “clear to sell” but has a one tooth width overbite.

Lot #20 FRC Supernova Memory (Nova) has been scratched from the sale.

Lot #23 FRC Tuf N Busy Vida (Vida) is “clear to sell” but has a one tooth width overbite. Visible swelling of hocks without lameness. X rays of hocks available upon request.

Lot #24 FRC Twistn Jitterbug (Bug) is “clear to sell” but has a small ½ cm umbilical hernia.

All horses sold are covered under the Feather River College Satisfaction Guarantee for 15 days, as designated in the Terms and Conditions section of the 2019 Feather River College Horse Sale Catalog. Buyer should thoroughly examine the horses prior to purchase and are encouraged to have a veterinarian of their choice conduct a complete pre-purchase exam on any horse offered in the auction at the buyer’s expense. A certificate from our Veterinarian is included in each horse file and is available in the sale office should you choose to review it. All horses are also covered under the Zoetis Immunization Support Guarantee for one year from April 3, 2019.

If you are leaving the state with your new horse, a Health Certificate will be required in addition to the Equine Infectious Anemia Test (Coggin’s Test) included in the individual horse file. Dr. Tanya Balaam will be available immediately after the sale to issue this Health Certificate.
