NOTES: 1. Fees include Health, Transit, and Student Representation fees which are \$18 per semester for Health fee, \$1.50 per unit for Transit fee and \$2 per semester for Student Representation fee. Fees based on full-time of 15 units per semester (which is the minimum load needed to graduate in 2 years). California residents: \$46 per unit; Out-of-state & International students: \$326 per unit (\$280 Nonresident + \$46 Standard Enrollment Fee per unit). Upper Division Coursework fee: \$84 per unit.

- 2. The breakdown for this category is as follows: books (\$594), educational supplies (\$135), course material fees (\$171), and computer-related expenses (\$180), excluding the costs associated with the purchase of a personal computer.
- 3. On Campus dorm housing cost includes utilities, cable and WiFi; Parent and Off Campus housing costs include utilities.
