Settlement Procedure

Acknowledgment of Purchase: Once the auctioneer's gavel falls and the auctioneer announces “sold” the highest bidder will immediately sign the acknowledgment of purchase brought to the highest bidder from a ticket runner/ringmen.

Payment: Within two hours of the conclusion of the horse sale, the highest bidder must complete payment in full within the horse sale office. Acceptable payment methods; cash, cashier’s check, traveler’s check, personal check, Visa, MasterCard, or Discovery card. Credit card fees applied. The buyer must present form of Identification upon purchasing procedure.

Delivery: Post payment, the buyer will receive a Facility Release ticket allowing the buyer to gain procession of the horse(s). If the buyer is unable to transport horse off the school facility May 20th, arrangements must be made for transportation/delivery of horse within one week, or sale will become void.

All buyers at this sale are bound by the sale terms and conditions set forth herein and are required to be read by the buyer prior to bidding. All transactions at this sale are governed and controlled by these terms and conditions whether buyer has or has not read.

All horses are offered for sale according to the laws of the State of California.

Every effort has been made to assure correctness of catalog. However, Feather River College Foundation, sales management, and auctioneers assume no responsibility for errors or omissions.

All horses are sold "As-is". It is the responsibility of the buyer to examine horses and speak to seller(s) prior to purchase. There is no guarantee of any kind as to condition, soundness or other quality of any horse sold in sale. Once the gavel falls sale is final.

Highest bidder recognized by the auctioneer shall be the buyer of the horse. If dispute should arise, the disputed horse will immediately be put up for the bid again. Auctioneer has sole authority to settle the dispute and auctioneers' decision is final.

Title to and risk of loss passes to the buyer upon fall of auctioneer's gavel. Upon fall of the auctioneer's gavel, a ticket runner will have highest bidder immediately sign an Acknowledgment of Purchase.

All horses sold will be provided with a negative Coggin's Test performed within 6 months of sale and a Health Certificate provided by the onsite veterinarian on the day of sale.

All buyers will be charged the current rate of sales tax on any purchase unless a tax number is given and the proper form is filled out. Payments must be made with cash, bankable checks, Visa, Mastercard, or Discovery Card within two hours of conclusion of the horse sale or else sale of horse becomes void. Credit card fees applied. No horse will leave until the final settlement has been made.

Once the payment of sale is completed in full, buyer must obtain a Facility Release ticket and must present to student handler in order to obtain possession of horse. If unable to take possession of horse(s) day of sale, the buyer must make arrangements to have horse(s) transported within seven days of sale. Buyer may board horse at Feather River College for \$15.00/day until horse is transported off facility.

Any persons attending this auction does so at his/her own risk and no liability, duty, obligation, and/or responsibility shall be imposed upon Feather River College or any of their agents for any accident, injury, mishap, theft, damage and/or any other harm regardless of the source of imposition.

The horses provided in this sale are utilized in the Feather River College Sale Program and course by students. Instructors do not train these horses, however they teach, mentor, and supervise the students. Horses sold in this sale are not considered purchased from a training facility or trained by professionals.

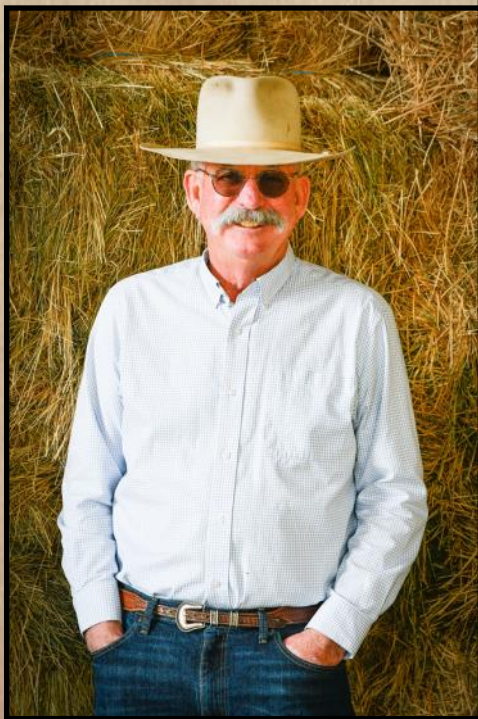

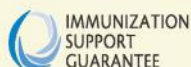
