Statement Guidance for Financial Aid Appeals

This is only a guide for the statement you need to submit with your Financial Aid Appeal.

1. For the semester in question, what was the reason you did not meet satisfactory academic progress? What prevented you from passing your classes? If you are addressing more than one semester, make sure that you create a timeline from the oldest semester to the most recent one.
2. How did this (your reason) impact your academic education for the semester in question?
3. What is your resolution and preventive measures? How have you resolved the issue and what are you doing different so that this situation does not affect your academic education again?
4. Do you have any supporting documents? Do you have any documents within the dates of the semester in question that can back up your statement? If possible, please provide a copy that we can keep.
5. Did you ever change your major in the past? If so, how many times and what were your reasons for doing so on each occasion?
6. Are you coming back to school after an absence of more than two years? If so, what are all your reasons for returning to college?
7. Have you been injured in any way that impacts your current or previous occupation(s) or are there financial circumstances that brought you back to college? If possible, please provide as much documentation for either of these scenarios.
8. Is there anything else you can mention in your statement that you think might help explain the various circumstances that are unique to your situation?
