As the month of October draws near, I wanted to remind families and students that the deadline to switch from virtual learning to in-person learning is September 30, 2020. This is also an exciting time for our school as we are settling into school and starting to reopen activities, athletics, and student events. Senior High Tigers will have the opportunity to run cross country at the SPL league meet in Custer County on October 3rd and football will start its first official practice this Thursday September 24. Junior High athletic directors are also currently making plans for fall athletics for 7th and 8th graders. Athletes should be prepared for those activities to begin when they are approved. Please also remember that each student's grades will be evaluated quarterly. To be eligible for extracurricular activities a student must be passing 5 courses at the end of each of the quarters. If a student does not meet these requirements, then the student is ineligible for the entire succeeding quarter. The end of the first quarter is October 15, 2020, and eligibility applies to all students both online and in-person.

I am also approving teachers the opportunity to organize small class trips again to allow access to local resources and activities. The student council and the district wellness committee are also organizing and planning events for students. As we start to plan and organize activities we will start small and we will keep a focus on student health and safety.
